HOW TO USE the FLUTE MUSIC CATALOG

You can search for a score by **Composer, Title, Publisher, or Type Description** (i.e, flute & piano).

Sorted lists are available in PDF files on the www.rfaonline.org. They also reside in a binder in the Library at Hochstein*.

You may find it useful to know -

The Type Description field is sorted by assigned numbers

The data base language is simple:

- accents and foreign diacritical markings are omitted
- if a score title begins with a number; it appears before "a,b,c"
- some score titles begin with numbers that are spelled out (i.e. "Four Songs"); they are listed alphabetically. If you are searching for a title that starts with a number, you may want to check in both places (under "4" and "Four")
- A column containing "comments" is used occasionally. It may describe something about the score (i.e, Autographed, or Oversize).
- "*Oversize*" scores reside on a box in the bottom shelf.

All efforts have been made to make the catalog entries accurate.
