*Irina Stachinskaya*  
in a Flute Masterclass on Sunday, March 31, 4:30 p.m.  
Hatch Recital Hall, Eastman School of Music

International flute soloist Irina Stachinskaya has had a storied career beginning as Principal Flute of the Moscow State Orchestra when only 14 years old. In 2006 when 17, she was appointed Co-Principal Flute of the Moscow Philharmonic Orchestra. Ms. Stachinskaya graduated from the Russian Academy of Music 'Gnessin's' in 2010 having been a pupil of Professor Vladimir Kudrya. She received her Diplome Concertiste from Ecole Normale de Musique, Alfred Cortot, having been the assistant of internationally acclaimed flutist, Jean Ferrandis. Ms. Stachinskaya maintains a busy schedule of solo and chamber music performances in prestigious concert halls throughout Moscow. Her ensemble 'KUI' (flute, harp, viola) was awarded the 'Golden Trophy' in the Second International Web Concert Hall Competition in New York City (2009). She has also been the recipient of other prizes including First Prize in the "Classical Heritage" Competition Moscow (2004) and First Prize in "Musicalia" Athens (2000). As a Powell Artist, Ms. Stachinskaya gives master classes all over the world, most recently in Korea, France and Brazil. Others include the Singapore Flute Convention, the Moscow Flute Center, Cannes Conservatoire, Krasnoyarsk Institute, Novosibirsk Special Music School as well as frequent visits to the Sir James Galway Flute Festival in Weggis, Switzerland, where she was awarded the first "Rising Star" prize.

**Masterclass Information:** Three performers will be chosen. Soloists must submit one copy of a recording via YouTube. Solo pieces written with accompaniment must be performed with an accompanist, and the applicant must provide the accompanist to perform on the day of the Masterclass. Performers must be in 9<sup>th</sup> grade or older and must be current members of the RFA. A teacher's recommendation is required for an applicant(s) in high school to confirm the student's high level of preparation.

Applicants must send approximately an 8 minute performance demonstrating contrasting styles (may be different sections of one piece, or 2 movements if applicable); Accompaniment is not required when submitting the application. Once masterclass participants have been selected, repertoire will be decided.

Performers will be contacted via email. Include name as it should appear in the program, and cell number.

**2. Required fees:** \$5 application fee. Once performers are chosen, non-member performers must submit an RFA membership form, Adults \$20, Student/Senior \$10. Soloists chosen to perform will be assessed an additional \$35 fee. Make checks payable to: Rochester Flute Association. Application is complete when check is received to Rochester Flute Association, PO Box 10173, Rochester NY 14610.
